Assesses and delivers snowsports instruction for individuals of all ages with various disabilities. Consistently follows organizational standards, practices, procedures. Attends required new volunteer orientation. Attends clinics both on-hill and indoors. Assists with the transportation, maintenance, and set-up of program equipment. Assists with special events. Develops and completes an intern project. Prepares for and participates in PSIA Level 1 in-house training program.

**Education:** High School graduate or equivalent. College degree in a related field desired.

**Experience:** Experience working/volunteering with individuals with disabilities. Experience working in a recreational setting preferred.
