Internship

ASMS is looking for a winter intern (academic or personal) for the 2018-19 season. Start date is flexible, between Dec 15 and January 3. Internship would be 15-20 hours per week and would go until March 31, 2019.

Duties include:

- Hands on learning about planning and implementation of programming, under supervision by directors, through Winter Adaptive Sports Programming
- Learn about sports program management through assisting in the administration of Winter Program
- Assist, under supervision, in the planning and execution of Winter Gala Fundraiser
- Hands on leadership experience, under the guidance of the Program Director and Assistant Program Director, through assisting the Bluebird Special Olympics Program

- Experience with computer programs: Word, Excel, ect
- Previous experience working with individuals with disabilities a plus
- Previous experience working in the snow sports industry a plus
