- You must haul items in/out at the designated time: Monday June 3 2:30-7:30pm at Hyatt Regency Rochester. Storage for equipment is not provided. DSUSA is not responsible for lost or damaged items.

Event FAQs

How do I get involved?

Chapters of DSUSA are invited to buy/sell/trade adaptive equipment at the Adapt2Achieve Leadership Conference. Individuals who are not affiliated with a chapter are welcome as buyers only. Buyers and sellers must be registered to attend the Adapt2Achieve Leadership Conference. You can join the Facebook group to list your items if you wish to confirm a buyer prior to the event. What can people sell?

Adaptive sports and recreation equipment in decent condition and working order.

What can people not sell?

Guns, knives, or anything that would be considered a weapon. Used helmets are not recommended. If in doubt about whether or not to bring an item to the swap, just ask! adapt2achieve@dsusa.org

How can I pay for items?

All transactions are peer-to-peer so payment method will depend on the individual. Some may accept digital payment methods, though most will likely be cash-only.

Can I donate items if I'm unable to sell them?

We have identified local organizations that will collect some unsold gear, but you should be prepared to haul it back home with you if it goes unclaimed.
